Job Description: Math Teacher

Bishkek International School is a non-profit community school providing excellent international education in a safe, supportive and friendly environment. The school opened in September 2011 and now has over 180 students with more students joining every term. Sixty percent of our students are American, Asian and European citizens, children of employees of embassies, international organizations and international business or NGOs. Forty percent of students are Kyrgyz citizens. The school welcomes all students regardless of ability, gender, ethnicity, language, or religious belief and everyone is encouraged to take part in all school activities. As an IB World School offering the IB Diploma, we are also in the authorisation process for IB PYP and IB MYP and Cambridge International Examinations Accreditation for the IGCSE programme.

The Math teacher will teach math in the IB Middle Years Programme, IGCSE, and possibly in the IB Diploma Programme, depending on student need.

Responsibilities

1. Develop and implement the math education programme for children age 11 to 16 following the MYP IB curriculum framework approach up to IGCSE level
2. Teach at all levels and set appropriate standards
3. Develop long term teaching goals for students and enable students to achieve the goals
4. Integrate ICT in teaching program and be creative in working with limited resources
5. Differentiate instruction to meet the individual needs of each student to be socially and academically successful having regard to the abilities and aptitudes of individuals
6. Provide a positive learning environment for each student and inspire students to expand their understanding and enjoyment of math
7. Plan, keep and report appropriate records to school management and parents
8. Organise and manage extra-curricular activities that promote positive interactions among students of all ages
9. Contribute to the overall development of the school
10. Maintain knowledge of current educational theory and practice and undertake professional training in liaison with the Head of Education
11. Act in accordance with the budgets, policies, procedures, directions and decisions of the school management
12. Act as ambassador for the school and act in a manner that upholds the values and ethos of the school at all times
13. Maintain high quality standards in all areas of the school
14. Any other tasks as decided by management that contributes to the provision of quality education for children or the effective development of the School.

Requirements

- Relevant University Degree
- Teaching qualification
- Successful experience as a math teacher for secondary school to IGCSE or equivalent qualification
- Familiarity with the approaches to formative assessment
- Genuine enjoyment of working with children and proven ability to enable a wide range of children to develop their academic and social potential
- Excellent interpersonal, team leadership and membership skills
- Able to communicate well with children, staff and parents and to gain their confidence and respect
- A commitment to Professional Development
- Near native fluency in spoken and written English

Desirables

- Graduate degree in relevant field
- Familiarity with the IB Middle Years Programme and IGCSE
- Other language skills

Timing and Duration

The position is available **starting 25 August 2017**. This is a full time long-term position with an initial contract of three years (subject to 3 months' probation) which will be renewable by mutual consent.
