Job Description: Co-Teacher

Bishkek International School is a non-profit community school providing excellent international education in a safe, supportive and friendly environment. The school opened in September 2011 and now has 260 students from age 2 to 18. Sixty percent of our students are American, Asian and European citizens, children of employees of embassies, international organizations and international business or NGOs. Forty percent of students are Kyrgyz citizens. The school welcomes all students regardless of ability, gender, ethnicity, language, or religious belief and everyone is encouraged to take part in all school activities. BIS is accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC) Commission on International Education. As a fully accredited IB World School we offer the IB Diploma Programme, IB Middle Years Programme (MYP), and IB Primary Years Programme (PYP). We are also a Cambridge International School, with Cambridge Assessment International Education accreditation for the IGCSE programme.

Responsibilities

- 1) Work within the assigned class group, supporting the Homeroom Teacher in using current curriculum;
- 2) Work with the Homeroom Teacher to differentiate instruction to meet the individual needs of each student;
- 3) Assist the Homeroom Teacher to plan, keep and report appropriate records to the Customer and parents.
- 4) Assist the Homeroom Teacher to organize and manage extra-curricular activities;
- 5) Take an active role in development of the school in partnership with the Homeroom Teacher, the PYP Coordinator and other teachers;
- 6) Act in accordance with the budgets, policies, procedures, directions and decisions of the school management
- 7) Act as ambassador for the school and act in a manner that upholds the values and ethos of the school at all times
- 8) Maintain high quality standards in all areas of the school
- 9) Any other tasks as decided by management that contributes to the provision of quality education for children or the effective development of the School.

Requirements

1. Qualified Teacher or an experienced graduate with equivalent teaching qualification or experience
2. Genuine enjoyment of working with school students and proven ability to enable a wide range of children to develop their academic and social potential

4. Capable of developing new educational programmes
5. Familiarity with Cambridge IGCSE and with IB Diploma programmes is an advantage
6. Excellent interpersonal, team leadership and membership skills
7. Able to communicate well with students, staff and parents and to gain their confidence and respect
8. Intermediate level in spoken and written English

9. Other European and Central Asia language skills an advantage
